THE TEAM

Maria Tran is a US based, Vietnamese-Australian award-winning film director, actor, martial artist, and cultural practitioner who is known for her work in the film and performance industry. She has a background in psychology, filmmaking, and working with culturally diverse communities. She is the founder of Phoenix Eye Films, a female-led and culturally diverse film production company based in Western Sydney. She has made international action blockbusters such as "Fist of the Dragon" and "Tracer" and has worked on movies ch as "Bleeding Steel" and "MEG" as a stunt performer. She is often described as a trailblazer in the creative arts sector and is often at the forefront of discussions and initiatives for culturally diverse communities. She will be co-starring in the Paramount Plus TV series "Last King of the Cross" in 2023.

Maria Tran is an actor, filmmaker and martial artist working across video, performance and action choreography.

TAKASHHARA DIRECTOR | PRODUCER | ACTOR

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Takashi Hara is a martial artist from Japan who is skilled in Wushu, Taichi and Xing Yi Quan. In 2015, he trained in traditional Chinese martial arts at the Qufu Shaolin Kung Fu school in China and went on to win the Wushu championship at the Otaku Tokyo in weaponry. In 2016, Hara moved to Sydney, Australia and has since appeared in several feature films, including "HEAD ABOVE WATER," "DAILY BREAD," "OPERATION AGNEEPATH," and "PACIFIC RIM: UPRISING." ECHO 8 will be his directorial debut.

Takashi Hara is Japanese native performing artist, martial artist and award-winning filmmaker & acting trainer.





Elizabeth H. Vu is a screenwriter who has written several short films that have been produced by filmmakers all over the world including MR GHOST (2016), THE CONSTANTS (2016), THE RADIO SINGER (2016), THE EQUIVALENT OF X (2017), LEVEL ONE (2017), UNDER THE BED (2018) and the upcoming EL HOMBRE DE LA LLUVIA.

She wrote multi-award-winning feature film THE PERCEPTION (2018) starring Eric Roberts and Nick Bateman. Her frequent collaborations with Phoenix Eye Films include the short film ROSES (2018) and the webseries MAI BICH PLANET (2019), BREATHLESS (2019) and GAME OVER (2022).

WAKE, her psychological horror thriller feature starring Fivel Stewart, is currently in post-production.



THERESE CHEN Associate producer | Fight Supervisor

Therese is a key creative member of Phoenix Eye Films, with a background in screen and media and visual arts.

She has experience in editing, producing, and fight coordination, and has been involved in various projects including the horror-comedy series NIGHTWALKERS, the anti-smoking web series BREATHLESS, and the community project web series GAME OVER.

She has also been credited as a fight coordinator for several action shorts, including the short film INTERCEPT, the feature action film ECHO 8, and the short OPERATION: KUNG FLU.





ADRIAN CASTRO VFX SUPERVISOR | EDITOR | FIGHT CHOREOGRAPHER

Adrian is a writer, director, and editor with a background in South American Indigenous heritage, born and raised in Sydney.

He recently completed a series for ABC iview called NIGHTWALKERS (2019) as part of an initiative with Create NSW called the Digital First Comedy Initiative.

Additionally, he completed his first feature film, HIDDEN PEAKS (2018) which is being distributed on iTunes by Gravitas Pictures. In 2017, Adrian wrote and directed a three-part micro series for Freshblood called TIGER COPS for ABC iview, a homage to 80's Hong Kong action cinema.

In 1993, he graduated from the school of Visual Arts, and in 2010 his short film DJANGO: SILVER BULLETS, SILVER DAWN screened at A NIGHT OF HORROR INTERNATIONAL FILM. He has also completed numerous martial arts action genre shorts such as ENTER THE DOJO (2012), GAFFA (2013), HIT GIRLS (2013) and ENTER THE DOJO 2 (2014).

Adam McPhilbin is a dynamic filmmaker and holds roles as a Cinematographer, Camera Operator, Camera Assistant, Editor, Colourist and Visual Effects Compositor. He is based in Liverpool, Sydney.

He graduated in 2016 with a Diploma in Camera Fundamentals from Australian Film Television and Radio School (AFTRS).

Some of his works include ABC iView's Nightwalkers (2019). His clients have ranged from Google, Lovefrankie KIIS FM, Ubisoft, Foxtel and continues to create video work for local media arts organisations including Curiousworks, Milkcrate Theatre and Phoenix Eye.

In 2017, Adam worked as a camera operator on Carla and Lisa's Countdown of Australian Art Series for ABC. In 2019, He worked on Fat Pizza Back In Business season 1 as a camera intern that led him to becoming the DOP of 7Mate TV series 'Local Council'.

THE PROCESS FROM PRE TO POST-PRODUCTION

THE IDEA OF 'ECHO 8'

'Echo 8' is a feature-length action film produced by the Phoenix Eye team in Western Sydney, with a predominantly Asian cast.

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The film was developed after a series of successful short action films, including 'Hit Girls', 'Enter The Dojo', and 'Tiger Cops'.

The director, Maria Tran, started her journey in the creative industries 15 years ago, studying Psychology and making short action films with friends.

Today, she is an experienced filmmaker who has worked with atrisk migrant communities, acted on Australian TV shows, and moved to the US during the pandemic.

Despite the challenges, her drive to complete a no-budget feature-length action film has never wavered.

'Echo 8' is a completed feature-length action thriller movie that is the passion project of the local filmmaking community of Western Sydney.

It is the first of its kind in Australia, being an independent and female-led action movie that was made possible through the support and collaboration of the community, including families, neighbors, and local businesses.

Despite the challenges of completing a 90-minute film during the COVID-19 pandemic, the team successfully completed the film and is now looking to showcase it on cinema screens and at international film festivals in 2023.

THE PROCESS FROM PRE TO POST-PRODUCTION

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LOCATIONS

The film "Echo 8" is an independent female-led action movie shot in various locations in Western Sydney, including Cabramatta, Fairfield, Villawood, Bankstown, and Liverpool.

The team used a red brick house as a focal point and shot in every room, including the living space, sun room, bedroom, and garage. Local businesses such as Quy Lawyers, VIP Karaoke Bar, and Bushido club also provided locations for filming.

The team was able to creatively use the spaces to make it appear as if the locations were connected.

CASTING

The cast includes a mix of actors with varying levels of experience, including veteran actors, local talent, and first-timers.

The film also has an international element with the support of casting director Mike Leeder.

Despite the challenges posed by COVID, the cast and crew have been extremely generous in overcoming hurdles to take part in the film.

EFFICIENCY

The film was shot over 14 days, with the script being developed in late 2019 and written in 10 days by Elizabeth H. Vu. Principal photography began in January 2020, but was temporarily halted due to the COVID-19 pandemic, bushfires, and floods, with final scenes being shot in February 2021.

Post-production was completed in December 2022 and the film had its first public screening on December 23rd and 24th, 2022. The gear used was a Blackmagic camera and a Panasonic GH5 camera, with simple lighting and a fast-paced shooting schedule.

Cast and crew often took on multiple roles and responsibilities, and the project was facilitated through a community and cultural development artistic model, with the cast and crew working collaboratively to create something for social change.

BUDGET

The total budget for the production of Echo 8 was around \$10,000 AUD and was self-financed through Phoenix Eye Films.

An additional \$11,400 AUD was raised through an Indiegogo campaign to support the marketing strategy for securing screenings and entering the film in festivals around the world. This strategy will begin in early 2023.

Echo 8 aims to 'empower'

MARIA Tran wants to put Fairfield on the moviemaking map.

The Fairfield local has just wrapped filming on a new independent action movie, shot entirely in the Fairfield LGA.

The busy filmmaker - inspired by Jackie Chan, who she has worked with on the 2017 film Bleeding Steel - is writer, director, actor, choreographer and producer on Echo 8, which is now in post-production.

"Myself and a group of young people based in Fairfield have been fascinated with movement and on-screen culture for a long time, and have made a lot of short films in our spare time, so about a year ago we got around and decided to make something to put Fairfield on the international map," she said.

"It's self-funded, lowbudget, with very minimal locations and cast and crew sourced in the area.

"We did the shoot over 15 days - which a lot of people would say is impossible - but

The talented filmmaker said it wasn't easy to juggle all her roles making Echo 8, but she was determined to make it through.

"Getting people on board is tough with a female-led,

hard-hitting action," she said. "But as we started shooting the word got around and people starting asking if they could be a part of Echo 8.

"The film has been very driven by the community it's very unconventional."

Tran said it was so important to her that the community was accurately represented, as she felt many times in the past her community had not been portraved properly.

"A lot of times stories are taken from the community and misrepresented, and we have to bear the brunt and the repercussions of that." she said.

"So I hope this empowers the community. We want it to have international appeal and I think if it's done right, this will do that, especially for an Australian migrant story."

Tran said she hopes to release Echo 8 into festivals but also find a way to showcase the film within the local community.

About 80 people and local businesses were involved in the shoot. She hopes to have test screenings done in the middle of the year.


